Transportation

New Orleans is served by the Louis Armstrong International Airport.

ITS provides attendees with airline reservations at the lowest available fare, plus —

Airport Shuttles and Taxis

The College has arranged discount fares on airport shuttles operating from Louis Armstrong International Airport to area hotels.

One-way taxi fare from Louis Armstrong International Airport to downtown New Orleans is approximately \$28 – \$30.
